

Call for Papers New Approaches to Irish English (Corpus) Pragmatics

Recent years have seen gratifying amounts of interest in pragmatics and pragmatic approaches, and particularly corpus pragmatics has developed into a new discipline with an emergent set of methodologies. The aim of this proposed workshop is to bring together different approaches to pragmatics and particularly corpus pragmatics in order to increase and share awareness of different approaches.

We invite contributions of research papers that focus on Irish English Pragmatics, including considerations of questions such as, but not limited to:

- Methodological innovations
- Multi-method / multi-media approaches
- Corpus-based approaches to speech acts
- Corpus-based approaches to deictic and discourse markers
- Socio-phonetic approaches
- Prosodic variation and pragmatics
- Annotation in SPICE Ireland

We welcome all papers in these and related areas. Papers should be for 20 minutes, plus 10 minutes discussion. Anonymous abstracts should not exceed 250 words (excluding references). Name, affiliation and contact details should be provided in the accompanying e-mail.

The meeting will take place on **April 26 & 27, 2019** at the University of Dortmund, North Rhine Westphalia, Germany. Details of accommodation and other arrangements will be released in due course.

As we will be applying for external funding, we would be grateful if you could already send a **preliminary** expression of interest with a tentative title by **September 15th**.
